

COSENTYX® e-Prescribing Favorites List



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BACKGROUND, INSTRUCTIONS, AND LIMITATIONS

These instructions are created by Novartis specifically to set up COSENTYX as a favorite, as well as setting up a custom medication in the Epic electronic health record (EHR) system and will not work for other conditions, treatments, or therapeutic areas, or on other EHR systems.

EHRs offer thousands of available medications at the provider's fingertips—making the process to find the appropriate medication time consuming. Beyond selecting the medication, additional prescription details, such as the medication dosing, routing, frequency, etc, need to be completed, often duplicating previously entered information. As pressures on providers continue to increase, gaining EHR efficiencies without sacrificing clinical quality is high on a provider's priority list.

Setting up a medication as a favorite eliminates a repetitive process and allows a seamless e-Prescription process, without sacrificing clinical quality and patient safety. In rare cases, the medication may have to be added as a custom medication if not available. A custom medication lacks important safety precautions information such as drug-drug interactions, drug allergy checks, and adverse events information.

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Favorite Medication:

1. Open the **medication order** screen
2. Type the name **COSENTYX**
3. Select **COSENTYX** and complete the desired medication details (**approved doses: 75 mg, 150 mg, 300 mg**)
4. Click **Accept**
5. Click the **star icon** in the summary sentence to save **COSENTYX** as a favorite

Custom Medication:

1. Log in to the **Medication Master File (ERX)** with authorized user credentials (or access the **System Administration** menu)
2. Select **Add ERX Medication Record** and click **OK**
3. Complete the desired medication details for **COSENTYX**
4. Save the record, and release the record to production after testing has been completed to satisfaction

Note: To remove the custom medication, log in to the **Medication Master File (ERX)** and select the desired medication. Select **Delete ERX Medication Record** and click **OK**. Save the record to complete the removal of the custom medication.
